Did You Know?



Scripture says, "Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me."

BUT...

Most people misinterpret this. People are told all kinds of things. Just a few are:

- Accept Jesus as your Lord & Savior
- Ask Jesus into your heart
- Say the sinner's prayer

You have to search the Word of God - *not* man - for the truth.

John the Baptist said: "I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Spirit..."

Acts 2:38 says: "Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

SO...

After repenting (turning away from "self" and toward God) and being baptized (by full immersion in water) as a sign of your repentence, the *ONLY* way you can be

connected with God the Father is by being baptized *BY JESUS* with the Holy Spirit.

Acts 19 records Paul the apostle coming across certain disciples that so far had only been baptized in water. Paul asked: "Have you received the Holy Spirit since ye believed?"

We ask you the same question!

When you are baptized by Jesus with the power of the Holy Spirit, you receive all the gifts and fruits of the Spirit, the first manifesting gift being the ability to pray in tongues, a spiritual prayer language. (Acts 2:4, Acts 10:46, Acts 19:6).

Most churches feel dead and empty because the people there are missing the power of the Holy Spirit within them. Jesus said, "...ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Spirit is come upon you..."
